## John Salminen Abstraction Workshop <u>Materials List</u>

The items listed are in addition to your preferred watercolor painting materials. We'll be working predominantly in transparent watercolor. <u>Please bring one or two full sheets of Arches 140 or 300 lb cold press paper.</u>

- Collage materials: magazines to cut up for collage materials. We'll need color and texture, <u>not</u> recognizable subject matter. High quality art/design magazines or architectural digests work best. Please don't cut out pieces ahead of the workshop.
- Glue: acrylic matte medium we won't need much but be sure it's 'matte'.
- Burnishing tool: I use a plastic sheetrock putty knife. You can use any tool that will flatten and smooth the freshly glued collage material.
- Masking fluid: to preserve white areas very little needed.
- · A toothbrush: for spattering.
- **Masking tape:** 2" is the most useful just the inexpensive hardware kind. 3M is good, Scotch...
- Acrylic paint: At least the three primary colors (red, blue, yellow) plus black and white. You won't need a lot so small (or shared) tubes are fine.
- **Tracing paper:** 8" x 10" or larger works. Make sure it's as large or larger than your sketch book. You'll need at least five sheets.
- Permanent black markers: one wide, one narrow. Sharpies work.
- **Drawing materials:** Your choice of sketch book and drawing tools but a sketch book of 8" x 10" or larger works best.
- A yardstick: Optional, for use in drawing grid on watercolor sheet.
